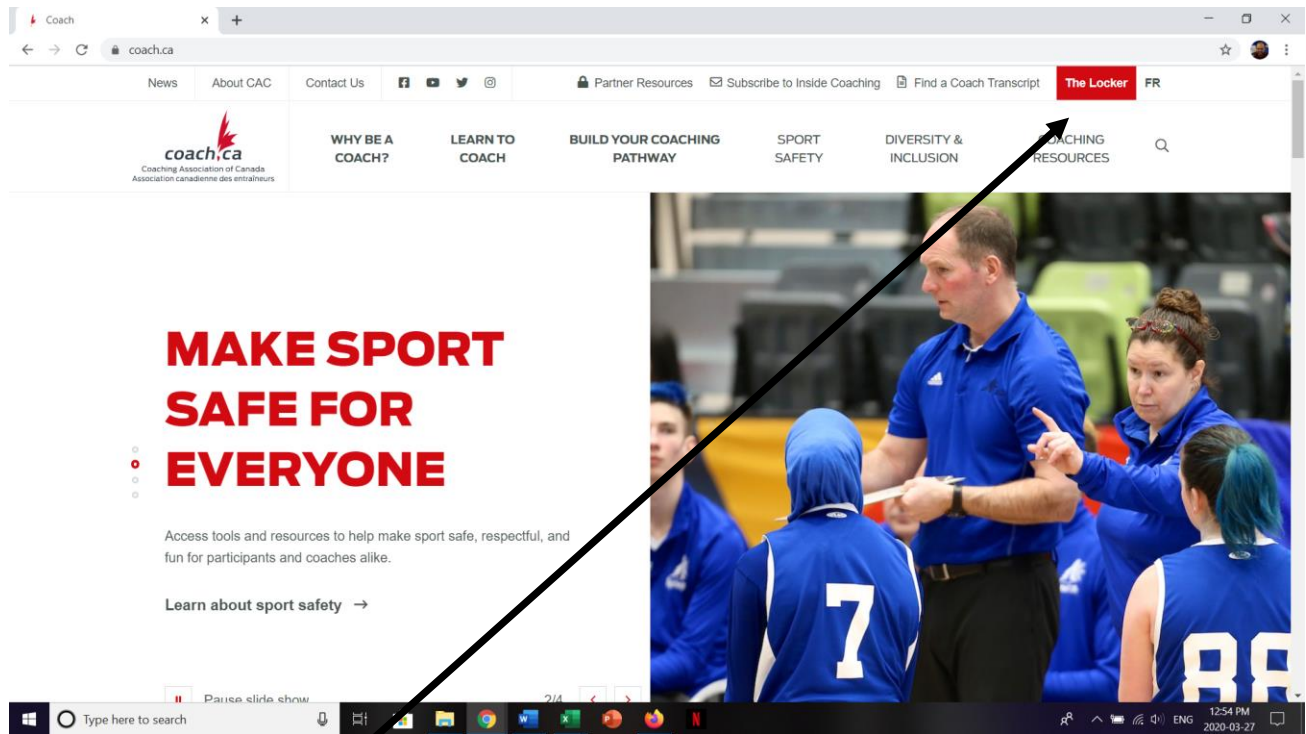


Using the Coaches Association of Canada – Locker

Accessing E-Learning in The Locker

You must have a valid NCCP number and password to begin.

1. Sign into The Locker by going to www.coach.ca from any web browser.



2. Click on “The Locker”

3. This will take you to the login screen:
